
FALL FESTIVAL

The Honduras Mission Trip through BMDMI

MISSION STATEMENT: Baptist Medical & Dental Mission International (BMDMI) exists under the Lordship of Jesus Christ to evangelize the lost, disciple the saved, and minister to the needs of the poor.

BMDMI, established in 1974, is a missionary organization that specializes in short-term mission trips focused on providing medical and dental care to remote areas of Central America & South Asia. Calvary has several members who journey yearly to Honduras to minister to the poor in a variety of ways. In addition to medical and dental care, patients are provided with clothing and hygiene items. Two of those hygiene items are soap and washcloths. Every patient is given soap and a washcloth. This month's mission is to partner with the team by providing soap and washcloths to distribute.

There will be boxes in both hallways behind the sanctuary for your donations. The soap and washcloths will be shipped to Honduras in early December so that they will be available to the team when they go in February.
