When a baby arrives prematurely or with serious health issues, McLeod Neonatologists, Neonatal Nurse Practitioners, and specially trained nurses step in, giving this fragile, young life a chance to survive and grow. The McLeod Neonatal Intensive Care Unit carries the Level III distinction, one of only seven in South Carolina, indicating access to unique specialists, imaging capabilities, and breathing support to care for babies weighing as little as one pound.

Donations may be placed in (or beside if too large to fit inside) the boxes behind the sanctuary.




