March's Mission of the Month is One Child At A Time

Mission statement of ONE CHILD AT A TIME: to eliminate modern slavery one person at a time by preventing human trafficking through education, rescuing trafficked individuals through intervention, and restoring human dignity through affirmation.

ONE CHILD AT A TIME began a campaign called "Rahab's Risk" in November 2018. The campaign is mirrored in the story of Rahab, a prostitute in the Bible who is remembered as one of God's faithful servants (Hebrews 11:31) and who found a new identity with God's people (Matthew 1:5).

This is the message of hope that ONE CHILD AT A TIME wants to share with women who are trapped in the life of prostitution in Florence and in the surrounding Pee Dee area. Most of the women are forced to work local motels, rest areas, and truck stops. They do not have money for the basic necessities because their pimps take all of the money they make.

A small gift bag called "Rahab's Rope" is given to women to show them that they are loved, that there is hope, and that they are worthy.

"Rahab's Rope" gift bags include the following items:

Ziploc bags-sandwich and gallon sizes

Crackers

Bottles of water-any size.

Panties -small, medium, large

Toothbrush

Soap -any size

Travel size

Tampons

Wipes

Mouthwash

Deodorant

Toothpaste

These items will be collected during the month of March. You do not have to assemble the bag; rather, provide any of the needed contents. Donations may be placed in the appropriate boxes in both hallways behind the sanctuary.
