August 18th



A LETTER FROM PASTOR MIKE



Caroline and I enjoyed much good preaching, teaching and worship with other Southern Baptists at the Southern Baptist Convention this summer in Birmingham. We are so thankful for your sending us there! It's a great time to hear from other churches and leaders and to reflect and refresh.

One of the highlights was that we were able to view a new Christian movie in a pre-release showing. The movie is "Overcomer", a story of a small southern town that is hit by adversity when the largest local employer shuts down. The key characters include a high school basketball coach and his wife whose marriage and family are affected when he loses his championship level team and is forced to coach a one-person girls' cross-country team instead; his one runner, a young lady with asthma, who struggles with never having known her father; and her grandmother who is bitter toward the man who ruined her family. Pricilla Shirer plays the Christian high school principal who tries to keep her school and these characters together.

The movie is tremendous! I highly recommend it. It will open beginning Friday, August 23 and will be shown locally at The Swamp Fox Theater.

I've been preaching on Sunday mornings through Ephesians, which is all about who we are in Christ and how we should live accordingly. This movie does a great job of taking a modern story and addressing the idea of identity in Christ. We are children of God and should remember that when faced with any adversity.

I was in seminary with Alex and Stephen Kendrick, the brothers who made this movie. They are the filmmakers who brought us such movies as "War Room", "Fireproof" and "Facing the Giants". They have hearts for the gospel and ministry. I highly recommend you make plans to see the movie when it opens in Florence, the weekend of August 23. I hope to see you there and in worship on Sunday mornings, as we continue to study important themes from Ephesians. As a bonus, we plan to show some clips from the movie as part of the messages.
