WMU MISSION OF THE MONTH: Jade Bridge

November is National Adoption Month

The Jade Bridge is a nonprofit organization that partners with adoptive and foster families to provide free resources, training, and social events to help parents deal with the unique challenges that come with adoption and fostering.

The Jade Bridge has been asked to help provide some much needed hygiene bags for a local Foster Care office. These bags will be given to children who have to be removed from their homes and placed with foster families. Some friends of The Jade bridge in North Carolina are going to be sewing the bags, but they could use some help purchasing hygiene items to include in them. Monetary donations are accepted as well (cash or checks made out to The Jade Bridge).

Listed below are the age groups with the items that go in each hygiene bag. Note: where applicable, items are to be travel size.

Items for each age group:

0-2 toothbrush, infant toothpaste, comb, individual Kleenex tissues, baby body wash, baby shampoo, baby lotions, band aids, baby powder

2-6 toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, individual tissues, shampoo, body wash, powder, lotion, floss in holder, band aids, ponytail holders (for girls)

6-10 toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, individual tissues, shampoo, body wash, powder, lotion, floss in holder, band aids, chap stick, ponytail holders (for girls) 10- up toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, individual tissues, body wash, powder, lotion, floss in holder, band aids, chap stick, deodorant (boys and girls), ponytail holders (girls), sanitary pads (girls)

You have the choice of donating any of the needed items (travel size), or you can put together an entire bag for a specific age in a gallon-sized Ziplock bag. If you choose to prepare an entire bag, be sure that you write on the bag the age group for which it is intended.
